### *Emergency Medical Technician - Advanced*

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***Aurora Launch Services has an immediate requirement for a highly experienced and motivated individual to fill the position of***

#### ***Emergency Medical Technician - Advanced***

**Aurora Launch Services (ALS):** Aurora Launch Services is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Alaska Aerospace, established to provide low cost, highly reliable launch services on a contract basis to both government and commercial space launch customers worldwide. The company is headquartered in Anchorage, Alaska, co-located with Alaska Aerospace.

**Position Description:** The primary role of the emergency medical technician (Advanced EMT) is to provide appropriate, efficient and timely pre-hospital advanced, intermediate and basic life support care and transportation of the sick and injured in accordance with local, state, and national standards of practice. The primary function of an emergency care technician is to provide stabilizing care to individuals and victims in need.

The Advanced EMT plays a key role in ensuring 100% Mission Success through the rigorous capabilities to provide immediate medical attention to employees, contractors, and customers during launch operations.

**Responsibilities:** The Advanced EMT is responsible for responding to emergency calls and providing efficient and immediate care to the ill and injured. The Advanced EMT will also provide care to patients at the scene and during transport to a medical facility.

As a minimum, the EMT must:

- Respond to emergency medical situations 24 hours a day and seven days a week during launch mission deployments to provide necessary assistance to employees and customers.

- Respond to calls for emergency medical assistance, such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) or bandaging a wound.
- Make informed decisions, exhibit sound and accurate judgment in a real-world situation.
- Assess a patient's condition and determine a course of treatment.
- Provide first-aid treatment or life support care to sick or injured patients.
- Report their observations and treatment to physicians, nurses, or other healthcare facility staff.
- Conduct a careful examination of the patient for signs and symptoms of illness/injury and assists other medical personnel as necessary.
- Administer prompt and efficient basic life support care within the limits of licensure or certification and in accordance with approved protocols prior to and during transport.
- Document medical care given to patient.
- Provide careful handling of the patient to and from the ambulance.
- Lifting of patient from beds or emergency scenes onto stretcher and into ambulance; carrying of patients and equipment; climbing stairs or steps.
- Provide a safe and efficient transfer of patient and patient care information to the receiving personnel at the destination.
- Document all aspects of a patient's condition and treatment on EMS run reports. Obtains and records non-medical patient information as required. Completes other patient documentation and forms as required.
- Must be able to read, write and communicate professionally and effectively with employees and managers.
- Must be able to drive large vehicles in normal and adverse conditions.
- Inventory, replace, and clean supplies and equipment after use.
- Attend all mandatory meetings as scheduled.
- Perform other related duties and assignments as required.

The position is Part-Time with varying work schedules depending on the location and duration of customer launch campaigns. Travel and working at spaceports worldwide can be expected.

### **Required:**

- Be 18+ years of age.
- High School Diploma or GED required.
- Alaska Certification as an Advanced EMT.
- Previous experience as an Advanced EMT.
- Knowledge of current principles and practices of emergency medical services, patient advocacy, and incident management .

- Knowledge of medical care and basic rescue techniques and ability to operate medical and basic rescue equipment utilized at the Advanced EMT level of pre-hospital emergency care.
- Knowledge of medical terminology, practices and procedures and applications of first aid, use, maintenance, security, and inventory of drugs, supplies, equipment and medical records.
- Current American Heart Association CPR Certification.
- Must possess or ability to readily obtain a valid driver's license issued by the State of Alaska for the type of vehicle or equipment operated.
- Must have good patient care and great customer service.
- Must be able to lift a minimum of 150 pounds.
- Demonstrated ability to manage multiple tasks in a dynamic environment and an ability to complete assignments with little or no supervision.
- Willing and able to work extended hours, overtime, and on weekends, as required.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Ability to drive company vehicles.
- Willingness to participate in the company's screening process, including drug screen and background investigation.
- Must be a U.S. citizen.

## Other Desirable Qualifications

Past working experience as an Advanced EMT in Kodiak, Alaska.

**Qualifications:** Qualifications for personnel to perform as an EMT shall include successful completion of a job performance evaluation within thirty (30) days of employment.
